



# How to Use Guide



## Pellé Fabric Spot Cleaner

Care for Fabric Surfaces

Pellé Fabric Spot Cleaner is specifically formulated to target spills, stains and everyday marks on fabric furnishings and soft furnishings. Suitable for use on most fabrics including wool, cotton, canvas, polyester, acrylic, polyamide and synthetic blends.

Prompt attention to spills gives the best chance of successful stain removal.

## Before you begin

Always test in an inconspicuous area before full application.  
Check the item manufacturer's care instructions before use.  
Remove loose dust and debris from the surface before treating.  
Use a clean white cloth to avoid colour transfer.  
If colour transfers during testing, discontinue use and contact Pellé for advice.

## Usage

### Step 1: Act Quickly

The sooner a stain is treated, the better the result is likely to be.

For liquid spills, immediately blot excess moisture using a clean white cloth or paper towel.

Do not rub, as this may spread the stain further into the fabric fibres.

### Step 2: Apply Cleaner to a Cloth

For best results, spray Pellé Fabric Spot Cleaner onto a clean white cloth rather than directly onto the fabric.

This allows greater control and helps prevent oversaturation.

### Step 3: Blot the Stain

Gently blot the stained area, working from the outside of the stain towards the centre.

Continue using clean sections of the cloth as the stain transfers.

Avoid scrubbing or aggressive rubbing, which can damage fibres and distort the fabric texture.

### Step 4: Repeat if Necessary

For stubborn stains, repeat the process several times rather than applying excessive product in a single application.

Patience generally produces better results than aggressive cleaning.

### Step 5: Allow to Dry

Allow the treated area to dry completely before using the furniture, rug, cushion or fabric item.

Drying times may vary depending on fabric type and environmental conditions.

### Ongoing Care Tips

Once the stain has been removed and the fabric is completely dry, consider applying Pellé Fabric Protector to help reduce future staining and make ongoing maintenance easier.
