## Pellé Fabric Protector

Care for Fabric Surfaces

Pellé Fabric Protector forms an invisible protective barrier that helps repel spills, reduce staining and minimise the build-up of dirt and grime on fabric furnishings.

Suitable for most household fabrics including cotton, polyester, acrylic, canvas, velvet, polypropylene and synthetic blends.

## Before you begin

Always test in an inconspicuous area before full application.  
Check the manufacturer's care instructions before use.  
Ensure the fabric is clean and completely dry.  
Vacuum the fabric thoroughly before application to remove dust and loose dirt.

## Usage

### Step 1: Shake Well

Shake the bottle thoroughly before use.

### Step 2: Hold at the Correct Distance

Hold the spray bottle approximately 15–20 cm from the fabric surface.

### Step 3: Apply Evenly

Using smooth overlapping passes, lightly mist the fabric until evenly covered.

Treat the entire cushion, panel, rug or furniture piece, rather than isolated sections, to ensure consistent protection.

Avoid over-saturating the fabric.

### Step 4: Allow to Dry

Allow the fabric to dry completely before using the furniture or replacing cushions.

Drying times will vary depending on airflow and humidity.

### Ongoing Care Tips

Reapply after deep cleaning.

Reapply every 6–12 months on frequently used furniture.

Treat spills promptly using Pellé Fabric Spot Cleaner.

Vacuum regularly to remove abrasive dust and dirt.
