Pellé Leather Cleaner

Care for Leather Surfaces

Pellé Leather Cleaner is a gentle, pH-balanced cleaner designed to remove everyday dirt, body oils, grime and contaminants from leather surfaces without stripping the leather's natural finish. Suitable for aniline, semi-aniline, pigmented, top-coated and finished leather.

For best results, always follow cleaning with the appropriate Pellé conditioning product for your leather type.

Before you begin

Always test in an inconspicuous area before full application.

If colour transfers to your cloth during testing, discontinue use and contact Pellé for advice.

Shake well before use.

Remove loose dust and debris with a soft cloth before cleaning

Usage

Step 1: Apply the Cleaner

Apply Pellé Leather Cleaner to one leather panel at a time.

You may spray directly onto the leather or onto a clean, dye-fast cloth depending on the leather finish.

The leather should be lightly damp—not saturated.

Step 2: Loosen Dirt

While the cleaner is still wet, gently work the surface using a soft leather brush or clean microfibre cloth.

Use gentle circular motions to lift dirt, body oils and grime from the leather.

Avoid excessive pressure or aggressive scrubbing.

Step 3: Wipe Clean

Using a clean, dry cloth, wipe away loosened dirt and excess cleaner.

For heavily soiled areas, repeat the cleaning process as required.

Step 4: Clean Complete Panels

Always clean the entire leather panel, cushion or section rather than treating isolated spots. This helps maintain an even appearance across the furniture.

Step 5: Allow to Dry

Allow the leather to dry naturally away from direct sunlight or heat before applying any conditioning products.

Once dry:

Aniline Leather: Apply Pellé Leather Revitaliser.

Non-Aniline, Semi-Aniline & Pigmented Leather: Apply Pellé Leather Conditioner & Protector.

Ongoing Care Tips

Clean every 3–6 months depending on use.

Clean spills immediately.
